2012, "The Well" will*

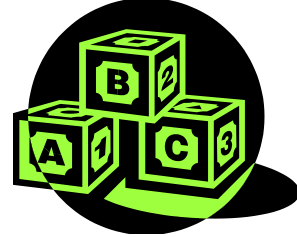
